students that if someone is teasing, hurting or threatening you that it is all right to **tell someone** who can help you.



As an added bonus, the stage is colorfully transformed into a **TV Game Show**. Two students and the principal or a teacher are the contestants helping to playfully reinforce the main points of the assembly program.

The puppets, **audience interaction**, music and **factual educational information** and **free activities page** will teach the students what to do if they are being bullied and explain the consequences one can expect if they push, hit, threaten or hurt another student.
